# Pack bio waste in a paper bag

- food leftovers, spoiled food
- innards from fish and bones from meat
- fruit and vegetable peelings, eggshells
- coffee grounds and tea bags
- keep bio waste separate from packaging materials.

#### NOTE!

Remove plastic from bio-waste, use paper bags from July 19th 2023.



### **Energy** waste

- diapers and sanitary towels
- dirty paper, cardboard, plastic and Styrofoam (polystyrene) packaging
- small plastic items (i.e. toothbrushes, hairbrushes) no PVC plastic products
- dust and vacuum cleaner bags
- dirty, mouldy and damp textiles (except shoes, rain- and leather garments)
- napkins



### At apartment buildings with 5 or more apartments



## Carton packaging



- cardboard boxes
- cartons, e.g. milk and juice cartons
- cardboard containers, e.g. cereal packets, pizza boxes, egg cartons
- paper bags
- toilet and kitchen rolls tubes

Cardboard containers must be empty, clean, dry, flattened and packed inside one another.



## Plastic packaging

- plastic food packaging such as yoghurt pots, butter tubs and packaging for cold cuts, cheese and ready meals
- empty detergent, shampoo and soap packaging
- empty carrier bags, bags and wrappings
- plastic bottles, cans and jars, preferably flattened

Plastic packaging must be empty, clean and dry.





#### Metal



- tins, non-deposit beverage cans, metal lids and caps
- aluminium trays and foil
- empty paint tins
- empty aerosol cans



## Glass packaging

- glass bottles
- glass jars

Glass must be clean. Remove lids and caps.

You can rinse dirty glass packaging with a splash of cold water.

It is not necessary to remove labels and bottles neck rings.



### Paper and batteries



### Paper



- newspapers and magazines
- flyers, brochures
- softcover books
- copying paper and pads
  of paper
- envelopes

Paper is collected at some apartment buildings, ecopoints and recycling stations.



#### **Batteries**

- all kinds of household batteries
- small batteries for mobile phones and other electrical equipment

Please tape over the poles when you remove the battery from the device.

Do not put plastic bags into the battery container.

Batteries are collected at ecopoints, recycling stations and stores that sell batteries.
